Korcula, Croatia - Monday, June 24, 2024: Forts and fishing villages, beaches and bazaars, sailing harbors and seashores- When Marco Polo set out to explore the East in 1271, these are the treasures he left behind in his hometown. Some elements have changed little in red-roofed, sun-drenched Korcula.

A Stroll through Korcula

Of all Croatia's beautiful islands, Korcula is perhaps the most visibly reminiscent with history. Its significant structures range from Marco Polo's house to medieval fortifications erected to keep Turkish invaders out and pirates firmly at bay. These landmarks make Korcula a fascinating town to explore. The main street does not cleanly bisect the town; but rather it zigzags up the hill and down the other side, with the side streets feeding into it at an angle. None of this is by accident of course. The zig-zags block the cold winter winds that blow in off the sea, while the herringbone layout of the side streets tempers the heat of the midday sun with some natural 'air-conditioning'.

On your walking tour, you will weave among the cobblestone streets of one of the most beautiful towns in Dalmatia. Stroll through the centuries and through a myriad of art forms. You'll start with the 14th- through 16th-century fortifications, passing the Rector's palace with its 15th-century turrets.

Step into the City Museum, housed in a 16th-century mansion and filled with an impressive array of artifacts that bring Korcula's history to life.

You will also visit the small cathedral and the Museum of Icons, and see from the outside the house where Marco Polo is believed to have been born.

Please note: Wear comfortable walking shoes. Conservative clothing is required to enter religious sites.

Get acquainted with your self-drive buggy during a safety briefing; then, start your engine and set off to explore Korcula as you discover hidden bays and beautiful coves from your two-seater convertible buggy.

You'll follow gravel roads above Lumbarda village through a gorgeous landscape of olive groves and vineyards. The first stop on your journey is at Lumbarda's famous, sandy Pržina Beach and LaBannya Beach. Don't miss this chance to swim in the clear water and enjoy the sun and sea.

At a local restaurant, enjoy a light lunch to restore your energy, as well as a tasting of local wines.

Return to Lumbarda and board your mini-bus for the ride back to Korcula.

Please note: Buggy's are reserved per vehicle (not per person), so only one person in the party needs to purchase the excursion. Maximum capacity of the buggy is 2 guests. Wear your swimsuit under your clothing; bring a towel, sunscreen and a hat. Swimmers should be comfortable in open water conditions. Bring local currency for additional purchases. Tour sequence may vary. Participants who wish to drive must bring a valid driver's license. Ride will be bumpy. Guests with back

Dalmatian Coastal Winery Adventure

Calling all wine lovers! Whether you're an amateur or an aficionado, your enthusiasm will be rewarded today as you navigate the wineries of the Peljesac Peninsula--an area known for producing some of the best wines in Croatia. The renowned varietals are the red wines Dingac and Postup, both of which you will be able to taste at the three cellars you will visit on this excursion. Crossing the channel by motorboat, you'll reach the well know seaside resort of Orebic, where your journey begins. Depart Orebic in the comfort of a motor coach, bound for the well-known cellar of the Grgich family. The winery is perched overlooking the Adriatic Sea, in the southern Dalmatia wine region of Croatia. Your destination is Prizdrina town, home to the Bartulovic family winery.

Enjoy a tasting of their fine wines (accompanied by a selection of traditional Croatian delicacies) as local musicians entertain you with a performance of Dalmatian songs. Afterwards, rejoin the coach and unwind on the return drive along the peninsula to Orebic, where you'll connect with the motorboat for the cruise back to Korcula and the ship.

Korcula, Croatia - Monday, June 24, 2024

Odyssey Cave, Snorkeling & Beach by Speedboat: A Small Group Tour

A scenic speedboat ride through the Korcula Archipelago brings you to the island of Mljet. Stop at the south side of the island to see a group of tall rocks shaped by waves over the centuries to resemble an amphitheater.

There are several small caves at Ropa Bay, including the Odysseus Cave. A large rock here is completely submerged at high tide. Legend holds that when Odysseus was shipwrecked here, he swam to the cave and was imprisoned by the nymph called Calypso. You'll have time to snorkel inside the cave if you wish, but keep a wary eye out for Calypso.

Ride the boat over to Vrnik -- an island famous for its rock quarry. It has a museum, art gallery and tavern, as well as a number of small pebble beaches. Stupe Island is popular for the Moro Beach Bar. The beach features swings out over the water. Relax and enjoy free time for a swim at the beach.

Please note: Minimum age is 12 years. Pregnant women or guests with back conditions are not allowed to participate. Wear your swimsuit under your clothing. Bring a towel, reefsafe/biodegradable sunscreen, light clothing to act as a full cover-up for further protection from the sun, and a hat. Snorkel gear is provided. Board a golf cart at the pier for a scenic drive along the coastline of Korcula town. Your driver provides informative commentary about the island and its inhabitants.

At Forteca, enjoy magnificent panoramic views of the Old Town before walking along the main street. The zig-zag streets block the cold winter winds that blow in off the sea, while the herringbone layout of the side streets helps temper the heat of the midday sun with some natural 'air-conditioning'. This design was also intended to bewilder the pillagers and pirates of the Middle Ages.

Walk with your guide among the cobblestone streets of one of the most beautiful towns in Dalmatia. See the 14th to 16thcentury fortifications and pass the Rector's palace with its 15th-century turrets. Watch for the house where Marco Polo is said to have been born.

Please note: Each golf cart has a dedicated English-speaking driver. The guide offers interpretive information at each stop and leads the group on the walk through Korcula. Wear comfortable walking shoes. The walking tour is optional; guests who decide not to participate can be dropped off at the tender pier. As you continue your exploration by kayak, you will have opportunities to swim or snorkel in Croatia's crystal-clear waters at various spots along the way.

After approximately 3 hours paddling around the archipelago taking in the scenery and discovering the underwater ecosystem, take a short walk back to the pier.

Best of Split & Diocletian's Palace

Today's Split is the product of 17 centuries of building, renovating and remodeling, so that the new meshes with the old almost imperceptibly. At the core of this sprawling cityscape is the Old Town of Split, set on the UNESCO World Heritage site palace of Roman Emperor Diocletian, built at the turn of the 4th century.

Your walking tour starts with a visit to the cellars of the palace, which are incredibly well preserved. The cellars offer a good view of how life in Diocletian's Palace was organized. It was and what began as an imperial residence and fortified camp is today an intriguing warren of narrow cobblestone streets.

You will also visit the very interesting Cathedral of St Duje (Patron Saint of the city). It is built on the remains of an ancient shrine -- reputely the oldest in the world. You'll see the

charming Temple of Jupiter, the Golden Gate and the Silver Gate, and Peristyle Square.

Enjoy lunch at the local *taverna* and spend some free time in the city center exploring on your own before returning to Zadar.

Board your transportation at the pier and enjoy a scenic drive to Petrolane where the winery Kraljevski Vinogradi is located. On the picturesque hills above Petrcane and Punta Skala the vineyards hang in the extreme conditions, on the rocky soil with an optimum slope towards southwest and with constant circulation of the air, from the sea and as well from Velebit.

They are one of the few large vineyards in Dalmatia and Croatia which are planted on a narrow row spacing so that a hectare has 8,000 grapevines.

Top quality grapes from the stone vineyards and excellent taste of wines are the results of a special microclimate, its position by the sea and a full day of direct sun exposure, on average 2600 hours per year. The view from the vineyards is overlooking the city of Zadar, the islands of the Zadar archipelago and Velebit. Explore the vineyards, learn of the winery history and traditions, taste the local pink, white and red wine accompanied by typical products before you return to the ship.

Croatian Interland: Vrelo Cave & Bajer Lake

Set off from the pier for a one-hour scenic drive from Opatija into the mountains to the popular Vrelo Cave, estimated to be more than 3½ million years old. This 1,000-foot-long cave has lighting systems installed, so you can enjoy the wonders of the continuously flowing underground stream, as well as the magnificent formations of stalactites and stalagmites.

Spectacular ancient dripstones are found throughout the cave system. Dating from between 500 and 600 thousand years old, these rare forms of dripstones are created by frequent fluctuations in the level of underground water flows. Use your imagination to recognize some particularly interesting formations including a pillar known as "the Bishop", and stalagmites known as "the Madonna" and "the Dwarves".

After leaving the cave, take a scenic drive to Bajer Lake and the picturesque village of Fuzine, located in the Mountain District for a short visit. From there, drive through the countryside to a traditional Vagabund mountain home to sample Croatian Gorski Kotar cuisine for lunch before your return drive to the pier.

Embark on a guided walking tour of the oldest part of town, Marafor, where the sites include Roman ruins and the famous Euphrasian Basilica. Featuring breathtaking mosaics, dating from the 6th century, and stunning Romanesque and Byzantine architecture, this basilica is spectacular to see.

Enjoy free time to explore at your leisure, perhaps picking up a few local flavors of the region to take home including delicate locally produced olive oil and rakija (brandy), made from local herbs and fruits.

Take a short hop to Rovinj, a picturesque fishing town, where historic architecture lines cobbled streets. Take a guided walking tour and then discover more of Rovinj's charms with independent exploration followed by a seafood lunch in a local restaurant.

Piran is the oldest of Slovenia's cities and is one of only three major towns of Slovenian Istria. It belongs entirely in another era, as it captures the essence of the Adriatic when grand Venetian architecture and rich color palates were the order of the day. Today, this charming and inviting waterfront city resembles a large open-air museum with a rich cultural heritage. Narrow streets and compact houses give Piran its special character.

Upon your arrival, your guide will welcome you for a walking tour through Tartini Square, 1st May Square, the St George Cathedral and Vegetable Square. Each house and street contains an important piece of history. After your guided tour, you will have some free time to explore.

Re-boarding your motor coach, take a panoramic drive into the hills beyond Piran. This is Slovenia's vineyard and olive territory. In the peaceful village of Samarje, near Capodistria in the heart of Slovenian Istria, you will visit the vineyards and olive groves of Ludvik Nazarij Glavina. They produce vintage wines, distinctive Samarje olive oil, and grappa. Step into the wine cellars for a wine tasting and a light snack before returning to the pier.

Truffles & Wine

Start with a panoramic drive through the region en route to the picturesque town of Piran, where you'll have a quick look around.

Continue to the Istrian countryside and a majestic winery located atop a hill. The vineyards expand down both sides of the slopes and are surrounded by olive trees. A truffle specialist and his trusty dogs will greet you. The dogs are sweet-natured and friendly, but don't be fooled -- they may be adorable but they are also true experts in their field, with a finely-honed olfactory sense that enables them to easily sniff out truffles. The truffle specialist you'll meet is also a fervent wine producer and private chef, so the story he will present to you will be one that offers a unique and comprehensive taste of the region.

Watch a truffle hunt demonstration and you will see that the connection between the humans and the animals is highly collaborative -- key to a successful hunt.

Next, your host will introduce you to the wine estate and the production of different wine varieties. Winemaking is an ageold tradition in Slovenian culture and remains a point of pride for the country.

Enjoy the views; then head inside to the cellar door and sit down to enjoy a freshly prepared lunch featuring the spoils of today's find -- wonderful, fresh truffles. A paired wine tasting accompanies each dish. The menu will be an introduction to the regional flavors, but the main flavor emphasis is truffles.

Stari Grad Plain

"Stari Grad Plain on the Adriatic island of Hvar is a cultural landscape that has remained practically intact since it was first colonized by Ionian Greeks from Paros in the 4th century BC. The original agricultural activity of this fertile plain, mainly centring on grapes and olives, has been maintained since Greek times to the present. The site is also a natural reserve. The landscape features ancient stone walls and trims, or small stone shelters, and bears testimony to the ancient geometrical system of land division used by the ancient Greeks, the chora which has remained virtually intact over 24 centuries."

The island of Hvar is a favorite destination for visitors to Croatia, thanks to its mild climate and lush subtropical vegetation. It is rich in cultural and historical monuments, and remains of the ancient times can still be seen in most settlements on the island.

From Hvar town, travel up and over the hill to Starigrad -- once the largest settlement on the and dating back to the 2nd century BC.

Visit the Dominican Monastery, with its rich library full of priceless books and paintings. After a short guided tour, free time is afforded in town.

Continue your panoramic drive with a ride to the village of Vrisnik. Here, a local host welcomes you with brandy and dried figs, followed by a special wine tasting and a Hvar-style snack. The island's wines range from light whites to full-

bodied reds, all made locally and produced only in small quantities.

Heading back to Hvar town, you'll stop briefly the fortress above the town, from where you can take in the magnificent view Hvar and Pakleni Islands.
